- c. All documents should be routed through the Head of the Institution.
- d. The Nomination Form is in 3 parts, viz:
 - i. Submission Details
 - ii. Innovation Report
 - iii. Annexure(s)
- e. The envelope should be superscribed '**AIMS-WeSchool Innovation Award**'.
- f. The last date for receipt of the cases is **31st July, 2010**.
- g. There will be two (2) prizes in each of the three categories in this competition.
- h. Winners of the competition will be invited to present their cases at the **22nd AIMS Annual Management Education Convention** to be held at **India Habitat Centre, New Delhi**. They will also participate in the Convention as invited guests and in addition to local hospitality, will be reimbursed AC (II) return fare by the shortest route for categories A & B and AC(III) for category C.
