GUIDELINES

1. The purpose of this award is to recognize Outstanding Teachers in Indian Management Schools. In this context, we seek your help in nominating suitable teachers for the Award.
2. Each School may nominate only one faculty member.
3. The following details of the nominee should be sent along with the nomination:
 - Name, age, designation and experience.
 - Academic and professional qualifications with specialization. Please mention year and university against each degree.
 - Courses taught and a summary of student feedback of each course, if available. Development of innovative courses should be highlighted.
 - Chronological list of publications in referred journals.
 - Publications of books with title, abstract, year of publication and name of publisher.
 - Participation and presentation of papers in National/International Seminars, Conferences, Workshops etc.
 - List of visiting assignments.
 - List of Management Development Programmes designed and conducted.
 - Major Consultancy Projects handled highlighting contribution made.
 - Contribution to Institution building.
4. The nomination should be routed through the Head of the School and should include a personal assessment by the Head of the School of the nominee highlighting the standing of the candidate in the profession as management educator.
5. The envelope should be superscribed **‘ICFAI Best Teacher Award’**.
6. The last date for receipt of nominations is **July 15, 2009**.
7. The ICFAI Best Teacher awardee will be felicitated and will receive the Award along with a citation at the **21st AIMS Annual Convention at Indian School of Business, Hyderabad on 27th, 28th & 29th August, 2009**. He/she will also participate in the Convention as an invited guest and in addition to local hospitality, will be reimbursed AC (II) return fare by the shortest route.
